

ORIGAMI

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Origami Paper or regular blank paper
- Pencil/Pen if needed to resize blank paper or draw on Origami at end
- Ruler to measure out size of paper if needed
- Optional: Glue, Scissors, Tape, colored markers

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS


- All supplies can be found around your house
- Special Origami paper can be purchased at Dollarama, Dollartree for less than \$2


WHAT IS ORIGAMI?

 Origami is an art of paper folding, you can create different pieces like; a bookmark, an animal, holiday themed decorations, etc all by using paper

PERSONAL MAGAZINE

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Old Magazines
- Blank Booklet, if you don't have one you can staple together loose papers to create your own booklet
- Glue/Tape, Scissors
- Optional: Pencil Crayons, Markers, Pencil, Pen, Colored loose paper, stickers

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Use blank paper/old booklets
- Old Magazines, Newspapers,
- Magazines less than \$2
- Glue/Tape under \$1
- All items can be purchased at Dollarama or Dollartree


WHAT IS A PERSONAL MAGAZINE?

- A Personal Magazine can be your own personal story, or a journal
- Cut out different images, pictures and words out of magazines and glue them into a small booklet or loose paper,

JEWELRY KIT

MATERIALS NEEDED

- String/Yarn/Eleastic
- Beads
- Optional: Stainless Steel necklace/bracelet as a base, Safety Pins, A-Z letters, 0-9 numbers, Scissors, Small Hand Clasp

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Yarn under \$2
- Beads under \$3
- All items can be purchased at Dollarama or Dollartree, Michaels and Walmart

WHAT IS JEWELRY?

- Jewelry are decorative items that you can wear
- You can make: necklaces, rings, or bracelets, that are typically made from or contain jewels and a band

DIY TERRARIUM KIT

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Glass/Plastic Container
- Soil
- Rocks
- Plants. Flowers
- Spoon to place Soil
- Optional: Moss, Tweezers to put items inside, charcoal, decorative elements

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Most items can be found outside!
- Soil under \$2
- Plants/Fake Plants under \$4
- All items can be purchased at Dollarama or Dollartree, Michaels and Walmart

YOUTH ASSISTING YOUTH YAY

WHAT IS AN INDOOR TERRARIUM?

- It is arranged for keeping plants or terrestrial or semi-terrestrial animals indoors
- The purpose may be decoration, scientific observation, or plant or animal propagation.

BRIDGE BUILDING

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Popsicle Sticks, 200-400 depending on how big your bridge will be
- 1 bottle of Glue
- Optional: Colored Popsicle Sticks, cardboard sheet behind gluing area, small characters to put on your bridge

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Glue under \$2
- Popsicle Sticks under \$3
- All items can be purchased at Dollarama, Dollartree and Michaels
- Optional: Colored popsicle sticks

YOUTH ASSISTING YOUTH YAY

WHAT IS BRIDGE BUILDING?

- Creating a bridge with Popsicle Sticks that are reinforced and can hold a light item on top
- Fun to do as a friendly competition between friends!

CLAY MAKING

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Dry Clay
- Water and cup
- Flat Surface
- Optional: Baking sheet for top of flat surface, small pick to make characteristics, sponge to smooth out surfaces, paint for finished product

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Water can be used from home
- Dry Clay under \$4
- Clay Utensils under \$5
- All items can be purchased at Dollarama. Dollartree and Michaels

YOUTH ASSISTING YOUTH YAY


WHAT IS CLAY?

- Clay is a soft, loose, earthy material and develops plasticity when wet
- Create your own clay trays, plant holders, coasters, and unique shapes/figures with Dry Clay

CROCHETING

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Yarn, thread, 3-6 rolls
- Use your hands to create patterns with Yarn
- Optional: More Yarn Rolls can be used to create a bigger item, Crochet Hook if needed, Thick Yarn for a big heavy blanket

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Yarn at Dollarama is less than \$3 each
- Yarn available at Michaels, Walmart for \$5-\$10
- Crochet Hook Michaels for less than \$5


WHAT IS CROCHETING?

- Crocheting is a process of creating textiles by creating different interlock loops of yarn, thread, or strands of other materials
- Can use a Crocheting Hook or without

OUTDOOR WINDCHIME

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Yarn/String to hang objects
- Most items like Metal pieces, bells, wood can be found outside or inside your house
- Optional: Beads, other decretive items you find

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Yarn/String at Dollarama is less than \$3 each
- Optional: Metal hanging objects from Dollarama is less than \$4/kit

WHAT IS AN OUTDOOR WINDCHIME?

 Wind chimes are a type of percussion instrument constructed from hanging tubes, rods, bells or other objects that are often made

BIRDHOUSE

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Wood or an old Milk Carton as a base
- Glue
- Water/Food Station
- Optional: Paint & Paintbrush for finished product, Markers, Hot Glue Gun, Colorful Paper and objects

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS


- An old Milk Carton can be found at your house, along with paper and glue
- Wood can be found outside, or at Dollarama/Dollartree
- Optional: objects to decorate your birdhouse from Dollarama is less than \$4




WHAT IS A BIRDHOUSE?

- A Birdhouse also known as a nest box, is a hand-made enclosure provided for animals to nest in
- Mainly used for Birds

FLOWER FRAME

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Old Picture Frames. Old Picture Book
- Dried Flowers, Real Flowers
- Optional: Glue if wanting to keep flowers in place

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Flowers can be found outside
- Dried Flowers and Real Flowers available at Walmart for less than \$10. Dollarama for less than \$5
- Picture Frames can be found at Dollarama and Dollartree for less than \$4 each, and Walmart & Michaels for less than \$10


WHAT IS FLOWER FRAMING?

 Flower Framing is putting Dried or Fresh Flowers inside a picture frame to preserve the life and beauty of the Flower

NO-SEW FLEECE

MATERIALS NEEDED

- 2 or more Sheets of Fleece or Fabric to start, different colored if desired
- Scissors to cut Fabric
- Flat Surface
- Optional: Ruler to measure out parts that are going to be cut out

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Use Scissors from home, Ruler if needed
- Fabric can be found at Dollartree and Dollarama for under \$4
- Fleece and Fabric can be found at Michaels for \$5-\$10


WHAT IS A NO-SEW FLEECE?

 Using 2 sheets of cut fleece and tie knots, you can make a no sew fleece blanket, couch cover, scarf, hat and other home accessories with just using your hands

JOURNALING

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Old blank booklet
- Pencil/Pen
- Colored pencil crayons, Markers
- Optional: Stickers, sticky notes, colored papers, glue, tape, ruler, scissors, paper clips

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Pencils, pens and pencil crayons can be found around home
- Can use old magazines for decoration as well
- Blank booklets can be found at your house or at Dollarama for \$1-\$2
- Optional: Colored Paper, sticky notes, cardstock


WHAT IS JOURNALING?

- It's writing down your thoughts and feelings so you understand them more clearly
- You can get creative with different colors, and styles

MACRAME

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Yarn Rolls, 3-6 or String if desired
- Optional: Wood as base to hang, colored yarn, old plant pot if wanting to make a hanging plant pot, beads to decorate

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Yarn or string can be found at Dollarama or Dollartree for less than \$2 each
- Wood Pieces can be found outside or at the craft section of Dollarama for less than \$4

YOUTH ASSISTING YOUTH YAY

WHAT IS MACRAME?

- With 3-6 thin yarn rolls, twine or string, create knots that have various textiles
- You can create hanging plant holders, decorative home/wall art, indoor round coasters, etc

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Using an old cardboard flat surface as a base
- Tape, glue, pencil, pen, markers,
- White paper, colored paper,
- Old Dice or create your own Dice
- Moving pieces or objects

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS


- Flowers can be found outside

- Picture Frames can be found at Dollarama and Dollartree for less than \$4 each, and Walmart & Michaels for less than \$10




WHAT IS YOUR OWN BOARDGAME?

TIE-DYE

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Home Made Tye-Dye: 1 tsp RITS fabric dye, 1 cup hot water, 1 tsp ordinary table salt
- Old sweater, t-shirt, sweat pants
- Bucket and Water to wash shirt out after
- Rubber Bands
- Plastic background/bag to set the dyed fabric on

WHERE TO BUY AND COSTS

- Old T-Shirts/Sweaters can be found at home
- Elastic Bands from Dollartree are less than \$2 for a bag
- Optional: Tie-Dye Kits available at Michaels, Dollarama, and Dollartree for less than \$10

YOUTH ASSISTING YOUTH YAY

WHAT IS TIE-DYE?

- The process typically consists of folding, twisting, or crumpling fabric before wrapping with string/rubber bands, and then continued by the application of dye or dyes
- Can create a different design everytime!
